

Duck Lake Crossing offers beautiful area and homes

The kitchens all have custom-finished hardwood cabinets; double-bowl, stainless steel sinks; center islands; and pantries all as standard features.

To get to Duck Lake Crossing, take Rand Road (Routes 12 and 59) north to Fox Lake. Then take the North Route 59 ramp turn-off and make a quick right onto Frontage Road, turn left at Chris Larkin Road and go one-quarter mile to the model.

The sales center is open from 11 a.m. - 6 p.m., weekdays; and from 10 a.m. - 6 p.m., Saturdays and Sundays-with additional hours by appointment. In mid-March, hours change to 10 a.m. - 6 p.m. seven days a week.
